Snippets from the classrooms

This week in Nursery we did some artwork using food. We made pictures of faces and thought carefully about which foods to use for the different parts of the face.

This week in Reception we have been looking at some real medals from World War 2 that belonged to Miss Harter's Grandad. We have talked about why we wear a poppy for Remembrance day and why it is important. We used the water colour paints to design our own poppy pictures in our sketch book.

In DT this week in y1, we have been exploring different folding techniques. We used our skills to make paper hats which the children then decorated.

This week in Y2 we have been learning to tell the story of Little Red Riding Hood using actions. We hope that you've enjoyed watching our video on Facebook. We've also created our own story maps so that we can write our own version of the traditional tale next week. They are fantastic.

On Thursday the year 3 children went on a 'network safari' in computing to understand how various pieces of technology are connected together. They may have even snuck into Mrs Wooldridge's office!

On Friday year 3 made chocolate art in the style of Jackson Pollark, ready for an art competition in January. The theme is 'tasty' and we can all definitely say that this art was very tasty! Year 4 have been working on a mini-project of "Pop-Art and Food" inspired by Andy Warhol. They will be entering their final pieces to a special art competition organised by Mrs. Barras. This week, Year 5 took part in a virtual activity with GCHQ (Government Communications

Headquarters) - the world-leading intelligence, cyber and security agency with a mission to keep the UK safe. We had to ask questions to work out who did what job within the organisation. Some people we spoke to even had to keep their identity hidden!

This week Year Six have been studying light and reflections. We had fun designing light boxes, within which to view different materials. We then assessed whether the materials were reflective or if they absorbed the light, making it more difficult for us to see.
