



Snippets from the classrooms

This week in Nursery we have been finding out about dinosaurs and fossils. We have learnt lots of new vocabulary and we especially enjoyed making our own fossils out of clay.

Reception - What an exciting time we had walking to Lowther Pavillion to watch the show 'Dinosaurs and All That Rubbish'. It was a great opportunity to visit the local theatre and we loved watching the performance.

We now have a new role-play area....'The Royal Palace' where you can wear your crown and have a royal tea party to celebrate the Coronation. Our portraits of King Charles are very life like, we are going to send a photo of them to him.

Our Reception and Year 1 class walked to Lowther in the sunshine to watch a performance of 'Dinosaurs and All That Rubbish'. It was absolutely brilliant! Thank you to the lovely staff at Lowther for making us feel so welcome and to the amazing theatre company that performed this brilliant show!

This week in Y2 we have been delighted to welcome our pet caterpillars to our classroom! We have been watching them closely and have already noticed that they have definitely increased in size. We can't wait to see what they'll do next.

We have been practising hard for our Class Worship next Wednesday morning. Thank you to all our parents and carers who have helped us to learn our words. We hope you'll enjoy it.

Year 3 have had a fantastic week exploring and investigating mass and capacity in maths. The children took their learning outside and explored whether items in the outdoor areas should be measured in grams or kilograms. Year 3 have also written diary entries in role of a character who is small and lost in a big city. We discussed thoughts, feelings and what they might have seen and heard throughout their day. The expanded noun phrases the children came up with were beautiful! Think we may have a few authors in our midst! Year 3 also explored plate boundaries in geography, creating a jigsaw with a world map and showing where tectonic plates meet, discussing what could happen when a country is on a plate boundary.

In Year 4 this week, we have been studying the course of a river from source to mouth and created a clay model using our sketched diagram to guide us. We attended our

2nd swimming lesson and we all made super progress. We have been learning about the Ancient Egyptian mummification process ready for our trip on Tuesday next week.

Year 5 have begun our swimming lessons and we are loving them! We have been investigating the effect of gravity in Science, have been studying women in the Old Testament in RE and have been making ourselves dizzy practicing angles in Maths. Our English text, The Sleeper and the Spindle, took a very unexpected turn this week which made us consider that things may not always be as they seem!

We have worked so hard this week in Y6 with the children gaining confidence and going from strength to strength. We did manage some outside learning too, in the form of a Maths scavenger hunt. The children had a great time and demonstrated excellent teamwork. Last week we took time to enjoy our new Gothic novel which we thought looked both 'spine-tingling' and 'bone-chilling' according to our hyphenated noun phrases!
