## English

### Units

- Innovated Story based on "The Way Home for Wolf" by Rachel Bright.
- Letters to and from characters.
- Non-chronological reports and information books.
- Poems based on a theme.

**Writing** - Write sentences with capital letters and full stops. Read each sentence to check that it makes sense. Connect sentences using "and", "but" and "or". Use "because" to give a reason. Use a range of adjectives. Use phonic knowledge to support spelling.

**Reading** - Retell and discuss less familiar stories. Record information from a range of non-fiction texts.

## Science and the Creative Curriculum

### Science

- Consolidate knowledge and understanding of Plants, inc deciduous and evergreen trees. Plant bulbs for Spring term (donations welcome).
- Find out about and describe the basic needs of humans for survival and medicine safety.

### Geography

- Use geographical vocabulary to refer to physical and human features.
- Use a range of maps.

### History

- Understand the difference between past and present and apply this knowledge to our local area.
- Identify some similarities and differences between ways of life in different periods.

- Record and explore ideas from first-hand observations.
- Investigate mark making with different types of media.

## Mathematics

- Place Value- Place Value of 2-digit numbers, Placing numbers on a number line. Ordering and comparing numbers.
- Practising our number bonds to 10 and 20. Learning which multiples of 10 add up to 100.
- Addition & Subtraction- Adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers, not crossing 10. Comparing number sentences and solving missing number problems.
- 2-D and 3-D shape. Discussing their properties and sorting shapes. Lines of symmetry. Making patterns.
- Multiplication and Division- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Progress to counting in 3s.
