

#### Snippets from the classrooms

Reception - This week we were very excited to choose what we were going to be in our Christmas Nativity called 'A Miracle In Town'. We went into the hall to practise going on the stage and speaking. It is going to be amazing!

Year 1 have begun a new story in English called 'Billy and the Beast'. We began by making predictions about what we think the book will be about. We then had to make a wanted poster for a mystery green beast! In Maths, we have started to learn numbers all the way up to 20!

Year 3 - In Science, we have been using our design technology skills to make a working model of an elbow joint. We have been learning that muscles make our joints move by expanding or contracting. We are close to finishing reading "The BFG," so have been writing our own review of the story and deciding if it reminds us of any other books we have read. We have started practising for the KS2 Carol Service on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December and are excited to see that Mrs Storey has got some of the costumes out of the drama cupboard!

Year 4 have been working incredibly hard investigating what happens when musical instruments are played in certain ways.

This week in Year 5 we have been identifying metaphors and similes in writing and songs. We have applied our new knowledge to creating our own mythical creatures, with fantastic descriptions.

In French, we started our new topic as detectives, using our prior knowledge of The Solar System to listen and spot vocabulary.

In Science we are testing a variety of equipment to separate mixtures of materials, experimenting and deciding which works best.

We had our final RE lesson with Rev. Emma and Rev. Nick this week. We have enjoyed learning from them, preparing for Confirmation and using bible stories to understand life as a Christian.
