Our Creative Curriculum

"Heroes & Villains" is the topic for the 1st half and "Super Sleuth" is the topic for the 2nd half term. The children will:

Science:

- Identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system and describe the functions of the heart, blood, and blood vessels.
- Recognise the impact of diet, exercise, and drugs on the bodies function.
- Describe how living things are classified.
- Give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on the specific characteristics.
- History - Anglo Saxons:
- Events in British history from the Fifth Century until 1066. This period includes Anglo-Saxons, Vikings and Normans. Children will have studied Anglo-Saxon society in more depth.

Art: Painting- An artist study

Exploring a selection of paintings through art appreciation activities. Collecting ideas in sketchbooks and planning for a final piece after researching the life, techniques and artistic intentions of an artist that interests them.

Music:

Exploring and identifying the characteristics of film music. Creating a composition and graphic score to perform alongside a film.

French:

Looking at animals, monsters and hybrids, use detective skills to extract information from a French text. Sort nouns according to gender.
