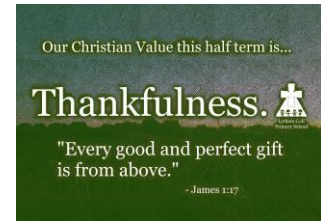
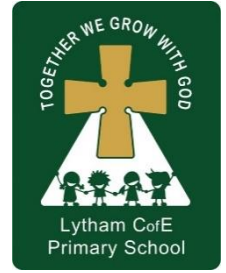

Snippets from the classrooms

Year Two - In our music lessons we have had great fun learning to play the glockenspiels. We have also experimented with crayon resist watercolour art and have produced some beautiful images. In P.E. we have been practising striking a ball and have improved our throwing and catching skills.

Over the last two weeks, Year 5 have been using fair tests to investigate thermal conductivity. During our investigations we realised we must be very accurate in order to produce valid results. In topic, we have been comparing the mountains of the UK and were shocked at how they compare in size to the world's largest mountain. We made scale models and placed them accurately on a map.

We have had such a busy week couple of weeks in Y6, including the opportunity to participate in Bikeability. We enjoyed being tour guides on our open days. Visitors were impressed with how knowledgeable and polite Year 6 children are.

We have also been learning about adaptation and evolution. We created beautiful peppered moths using real salt and pepper to create an impressive, speckled effect. We also recreated Darwin's finches using tweezers, pegs and tongs to emulate their differing beaks. We had fun timing the birds feeding on a variety of seeds and working out which ones would survive and thrive.
