

English – The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe

Outcome: During this unit of work the children will initially build up to writing a narrative story based on entering into a magical land. The non-fiction study will link into writing a non-chronological report based on mythical creatures.

Guided Reading: This will follow the carousel structure where each child reads once a week with the teacher in a guided group. Structured reading tasks will be set around the group reading text each day.

Spelling: Initially the children will recap on the Year 4 statutory spellings before moving onto learning the Year 5 statutory words and spelling patterns following the No Nonsense Scheme.

Comprehension: A weekly written comprehension task will take place in class that is supplemented by other reading tasks in the English lesson.

Maths – This term the focus is on Place Value. Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division.

Reading Roman Numerals to 1,000.

Reading and writing numbers to 1,000,000.

Partitioning numbers to 1,000,000.

Comparing and ordering numbers to 100,000.

Rounding to the nearest 10, 000 or 1,000.

Mental strategies of addition and subtraction.

Adding whole numbers with more than four digits.

Subtracting whole numbers with more than four digits.

Common multiples, factors and square numbers.

Multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1,000.

Explaining the stages in a life cycle of different mammals, birds, amphibians and insects.
