

**English** – In English, we are starting our new topic of Mythology. In this unit, children will learn about different Greek Mythology stories and characters. Our grammar focus this term is personification, where children be able to come up with their own examples of personification, as well as being able to identify personification in a range of texts.

**Guided Reading** will continue to be taught daily.

**Maths** – We have lots to be looking at in Maths this term, including decimals and negative numbers. Students will explore complements to 1, adding and subtracting decimals and multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000.

**Science** – We are continuing our unit of properties, changes and separating materials, followed by living things and their habitats. In this unit, students will learn about the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects, and birds, and the reproduction process in plants and animals. We will also focus on recording data, presenting findings with conclusions, and evaluating scientific evidence to support or refute ideas in various presentation formats.

**RE** – In RE, children will start to look at whether death is an ending or beginning. Children will be given the opportunity to ask questions and discuss their feelings and express their ideas and perceptions of death, loss, heaven and eternal life.

**Geography/History** – we are continuing our unit of ‘water, water everywhere’, followed by our history unit of Ancient Greece.

**DT** – Our new topic for DT this term is Cooking and nutrition: developing a recipe. In this unit, children will learn about the process of how ingredients are grow and processed, make adaptations to design a recipe, evaluate nutritional content, practice food preparation skills, design a label, and finish off by following a recipe to make a Spaghetti Bolognese.

**Computing** – In computing, children will look at flat-file databases. This unit looks at how a flat-file database can be used to organise data in records. Pupils use tools within a database to order and answer questions about data. They create graphs and charts from their data to help solve problems. They use a real-life database to answer a question, and present their work to others.

**Music** – In music, children will be looking at musical theatre, where they will learn about the different roles, categorise different songs. They will build their knowledge to create their own scene.

**PE** – In PE, we are looking at working as a team in outdoor adventurous activities. This unit will assess children’s ability to work together to solve problems. On Fridays, we are also continuing on from last term, looking at athletics to prepare for sports day.

**PSHE** – In PSHE, we are looking at keeping safe. Children will be able to identify different types of bullying and different types of risks that they face or may face in later life. They will also work on decision making.

**French** – We are continuing our unit of verbs (action), followed by ‘meet my French family’ where children will apply their understanding of French pronunciation and recognise key information in a text.
